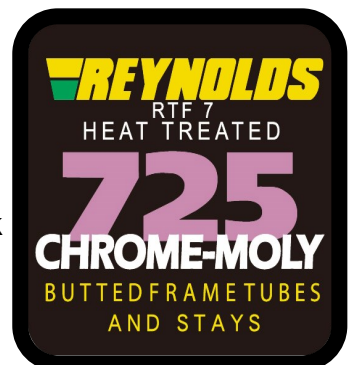

But Scott Napier bought a Club Tour from us and then used it to become the new

Guinness World Record Holder for cycling the Pan American Highway.

14,050 miles from Alaska to Tierra del Fuego in 125 days -
 Scott smashed 15 days off the previous record!
